Beginning our first Sunday in January:


- 8:30am ..... Praise Worship




# LIGHT SWITCH COVER

Everyone who believes in God and lives for him is a child of light. Make this cover for your bedroom light switch to remind you to be a light for God.

**What you need:**

- An adult to help
- Light switch cover
- Screwdriver
- Colored paper
- Markers
- Scissors
- Decoupage glue
- Paintbrush
- Craft knife



**What you do:**

1. Remove the screws from the cover.
2. On the paper, draw small images related to light and write out "Live as children of light" (Ephesians 5:8, NIV).
3. Cut out the drawings and verse. Make sure they'll fit on the cover.
4. Paint the cover with a coat of decoupage glue, and then immediately place the drawings and verse on the cover.
5. Paint over them with another coat of glue. Let it dry.
6. Turn the cover over and use a craft knife to cut out the opening for the light switch.
7. Using a screwdriver, place your new light switch cover on your wall.



## 2011: When we "Do the DO!"



2010 finished with the church meeting around the ideas of mission and financing. We met in small groups, committees and the whole church at different times. ## Join us in being a Hope Companion

As our family's way of fulfilling our Christmas pledge, we will be adopting 1 family through being a Hope Companion of ZOE ministry. Pooling this gift with others would make it even more effective. We want to invite 19 other families/individuals or groups (like a youth group, UMW, UMMen, etc.) to form a "working group", where we could adopt a group of 20 families of orphans through the program from ZOE Ministry. Over the course of the 3 years, support would average \$1/day per family.

The thing that attracted us to this is that we have seen how this program can change a family forever-introducing them to the love of Jesus while also giving them the chance to support their family for a lifetime. I am hoping we can team together to form a "Working Group" and really impact the lives of these families this year.
