May God's grace and peace be with you! Take care....peace...and be safe!

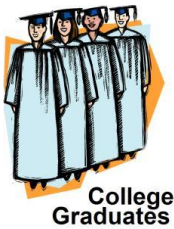

Create this artwork to express your love and appreciation for your dad or another special man this Father's Day.

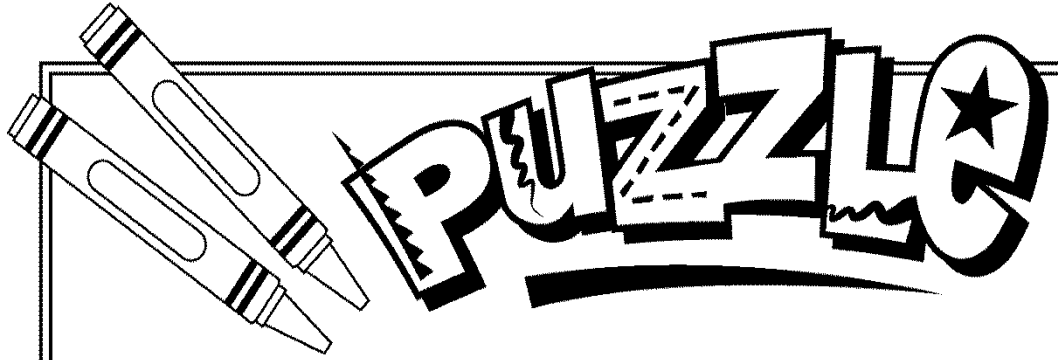


What you need:
